As we close in on our Summer Band dates I wanted to send an informational letter to each of you outlining some procedures and hopefully answering some of the questions that are inevitable in this unprecedented fall semester.

First week:

All students who have enrolled for band should plan on attending Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday. On Thursday we will have marching and playing auditions, all members should audition (even those who are not planning on being in contest marching band). Friday and Saturday will be for those who have a spot in the Contest Marching Band.

- Wear tennis/athletic shoes, no flip-flops!
- Bring and wear a mask!
- We will be outside most of the time so please wear cool clothing and sunscreen is advisable.
- When checking in every students temperature will be taken daily.
- Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or symptoms and over or any of the symptoms listed on the health survey will need to go back home and will not be allowed to rehearse.

- Every student will need to fill out the online health survey and present a screenshot of their answers daily. The health survey is accessible at **mooreband.com**
- Any student who is sick should stay home that day!
- When we have indoor sectionals and during breaks students will maintain a social distance!

During the first 9 weeks we will rehearse concert band 1st hour (or 3rd hour for Freshman) and contest marching band will practice from 3:30-5:00 pm daily. When we rehearse indoors 1st hour will be split into four different rooms to better reduce numbers and enable us to better social distance.

Our goal in marching band is to rehearse and perform at a Superior level. We cannot control what contests will cancel and what we can perform at but this should not affect the way we prepare and the joy we gain by being together and making music.
